Home-Academy Partnership Agreement



The Home-Academy Partnership Agreement is based on the belief that students do their best when they are supported, know what to expect and know what is expected of them. We understand that the partnership involves the Academy, the students and their parents/carers. The contract which follows aims to clarify this partnership and build on the aims as set out in the Academy prospectus.

The Governors agree that the Academy will:

- provide a welcoming environment where its aims and aspirations become a day to day reality;
- care for our students' safety, happiness and well being;
- provide a balanced curriculum within the National Curriculum guidelines that meets the individual needs of our students;
- let you know about any concerns or problems that affect your child's work or behaviour;
- provide regular reports on each students attainment and progress;
- arrange parents' meetings where progress and targets can be discussed;
- invite our students to participate in a wide range of extra curricular academy opportunities;
- recognise and reward effort and achievement.

The Student agrees to:

- attend the Academy on time and in uniform
- arrive at lessons punctually and prepared with the correct equipment needed each day
- take full advantage of the opportunities offered by the Academy
- record homework in your personal planner and complete homework on time
- be responsible for delivering reports, letters and other information home promptly
- accept your responsibilities and respect the rights of others

- check and sign your child's planner on a weekly basis
- provide suitable emergency contacts
