Sessions will be limited to three to five students per group and will be above and beyond normal timetabled hours. Students will be prioritised for small group tuition based on the guidance released by the Education and Skills Funding Agency (ESFA).</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Those with an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan (3 students) • Those who have a grade 4 or below in GCSE Maths (31 Students) and/or English (25 students) • Level 2 students and some level 3 students on vocational courses who have experienced disrupted learning • Those with special educational needs and disabilities (39 SEND in year 12: 10 Students in year 13), particularly where they have experienced additional disruption to learning as a result of their specific needs and disabilities. • There are 195 students in year 12 and 137 students in year 13.
