Shoreham Academy is a co-educational school open to students aged 11-19. There are 300 places in Year 7, all of which are open to students of all abilities and all backgrounds.

Our aim is to bring out the “best in everyone” – students, staff, parents and the local community. With an ethos based on the key values of excellence, hard work and integrity, we support students as they develop into responsible and caring citizens.

We encourage students to aim high and we support them in pursuing their dreams. At our academy, success of every kind is celebrated and no child is overlooked. With a rich and varied curriculum and a wide range of enrichment activities, the opportunities for students to flourish are unlimited.

A WELCOMING AND SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT

Our academy community is a happy and welcoming one. Students thrive in a supportive and safe environment in which everyone has respect for one another. We maintain a high standard of discipline so that the classroom focus remains on high-quality teaching and learning.

We know that starting a new school can often be a frightening and unsettling time for children. We make every effort to ensure our Year 7 students feel comfortable and supported from their very first day. To give students a better idea of what to expect when they join the academy, we hold Year 5 Fun Days, Year 6 Taster Days and Year 7 Induction Days.



Building effective relationships is key; our “Schools within Schools” system ensures every student is known and valued for what they can achieve.

Our three Schools are named after famous authors who lived in Sussex – H.G. Wells, Arthur Conan Doyle and Rudyard Kipling. Each has its own Head of School, Non-Teaching Pastoral Managers and is headed up by members of the Leadership Team.

Schools are made up of Mentor Groups which contain approximately 30 students from one year. Mentors remain with their mentees as they progress from Year 7 to Year 11, providing a safe environment where mentors can really get to know their students and build valuable relationships with them.

AN EXCITING AND STIMULATING CURRICULUM


At Shoreham Academy our focus is always on teaching and learning. Whilst our curriculum is designed to give students the skills and qualifications they need to pursue successful careers it also seeks to give students a lifelong love of learning. We want students to enjoy their lessons and be inspired to continue learning beyond the classroom.

In their first three years at the academy, students study a broad and balanced range of subjects which cover the key areas of the National Curriculum. We pay particular attention to developing the core skills of literacy and numeracy since, without these, students are unable to access the rest of the curriculum.

There is also an emphasis on the skills required for students to become effective learners, responsible citizens and confident individuals. One of the ways that we do this is through our EBacc Excellence programme where students in year 7 follow themes that relate learning to local, national and global contents.

As students progress through the academy, they can choose from a wide range of both academic and vocational subjects to suit their own strengths and interests.

NURTURING EACH INDIVIDUAL STUDENT

At the heart of our approach to teaching is a focus on the individual and their personal learning journey.

Our Individual Learning Programme means that every student receives an education which challenges and supports them. We give our more able students the chance to excel through our APEX programme whilst we provide extra help to students with Special Educational Needs (both with and without EHCPs) and those who may be struggling in certain areas of the curriculum.

Every student's progress is monitored continuously. We do not allow anyone to slip into the realm of underachievement. Students attend regular meetings with their mentors where they discuss their progress and set targets for the future.



Our most important partnership is the one we have with parents and we encourage them to play an active role in the education of their child. We communicate with parents about their child's progress through regular reports home. Our parents' evenings provide parents with the opportunity to come to the academy to see what work their child is doing and meet their child's teachers. If, at any time, a parent wishes to discuss any concerns they may have about their child's time at the academy, they are always welcome to make an appointment to meet with their child's mentor or classroom teachers.

BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

At Shoreham Academy academic success goes hand-in-hand with development outside the classroom. We want our students to leave the academy with a complete range of skills which will fully prepare them for adult life. All students participate in the 'Shoreham Academy Experience' with the expectation of fulfilling a number of pledges in preparation for their future.

As part of our extended day, which includes a Breakfast Club and after school activities, every student has the chance to try new and fun activities which will help them develop skills for life. Whether a student competes in a sports team, works on an academy production either on-stage or backstage, belongs to a dance club or participates in the Duke of Edinburgh's Award scheme, they will find the experience both rewarding and enjoyable. We are always open to new ideas and if there is demand for a particular activity we will always try our best to make it happen.

In the summer term all students have the opportunity to enjoy our fabulous experience week. This offers them a wide ranging choice of international, national residential and local trips as well as the chance to experience fun and interesting activities outside of the normal school curriculum.

We also encourage all students to play their part in the life of the academy. By taking on roles of responsibility, such as Year 11 Leadership Team, Student Leaders and Student Council representatives, students have the opportunity to develop leadership skills and make a positive contribution to our academy community.


SPECTACULAR BUILDINGS
