Work to complete

Task 1: Write a report:

Lockdown and technology.

There is no doubt that, had the corona virus pandemic occurred 15 years earlier when technology was very different, the response to the pandemic and the public's experience would have been very different. Write about how the technology that most people have available today affected our experience of the pandemic and also how it affected the response to the pandemic. You could focus on how it has had an impact on:

- Communications
- Entertainment
- Tracking the spread of the virus
- The spread of information (both accurate and inaccurate)
- Any other aspect of life while the Covid 19 measures were in force.

Your report will probably contain accounts of how technology helped track contagion and also of how technology made the lockdown more bearable for many of us but to write a proper account you also need to consider whether it also had any negative effects.

Task 2: Research Websites and Apps. Evaluate 3 different websites or different Apps and how they were used or made a difference during the response to Covid 19. You need to create an information page for each – think about target audience, information on the app/website, housestyle, ease of use of the website or App. You should include appropriate images of each.
