A Level art is all about deep contextual research and independent study informing your development of ideas. Guided by one-to-one tutorials each student creates a body of work of visual and written work that is individual to them.

We want you to come to the course ready to experiment with new techniques, processes and ways of thinking. To be excited by different forms of art and to be able to articulate your opinions.

You need to be committed to attending all your lessons on time, completing work to your deadlines and using the art spaces, including your own 6th form room, in your own independent lesson time in order to create high quality personal responses.

Please explore the following tasks:

Work to complete

You are asked to respond to the theme of '**close-ups**' by producing a series of work or a sketchbook based on the theme.

You should carry out research at home. You can use the internet and Pinterest to help you find sources to inspire you.

We would like you to develop and produce work in a choice of media, including:

- drawing, painting and mixed media
- moving image
- three-dimensional constructions.

Tasks:

1. Create an A4 visual mind map on the theme of 'Close ups'
2. Pick one aspect from your mind map to take further and take 24 photos linking to this topic
3. Create a couple of drawings/painting/mixed media pieces or 3d outcomes if preferred from your photographs – these could be sections of or whole photographs
4. Visit a museum, or at least its website and create a write up, including analysis of the work you have seen (see list of museums below) and images of work
