Btec Nationals Level 3 Uniformed Protective Services (2020) is a vocational course that has a specialist work-related focus. You will gain a solid understanding of the skills and demands required for a career in the Uniformed Public Services, learning about a range of areas such as leadership, health and lifestyle, citizenship, politics and law.

You will have the opportunity to take part in activities which will enhance your understanding of a career in the industry. For example: opportunities to go on residential visits to develop team work and leadership skills, experience water and land based adventurous activities, meet a range of guest speakers from the Army, Navy and the Police, and participate in vocational scenarios, Police training and recruitment events.

This qualification is for those students who have a genuine interest in a range of uniformed and non-uniformed Public Services. It will prepare them for appropriate direct employment in the vocational sector or to go on to study further at University.
